## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 20-2-153.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, the "Georgia
- 2 Early Literacy Act," so as to provide for criteria for core curricula for state approved educator
- 3 preparation programs aligned to the science of reading to guide curricula and instruction; to
- 4 provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 20-2-153.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, the "Georgia Early
- 8 Literacy Act," is amended by adding a new subsection to read as follows:
- 9 "(d.1) The Professional Standards Commission shall adopt rules which establish criteria
- 10 <u>for core curricula for each state approved educator preparation program. Such rules shall</u>
- include, but shall not be limited to, the following:
- 12 (1) The use of content standards established by the State Board of Education that are
- aligned to the science of reading to guide curricula and instruction;
- 14 (2) Evidence based standards for the teaching of reading that:
- 15 (A) Are exclusively aligned with the science of reading;

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16 (B) Prepare teachers to provide explicit, systematic, sequential, and cumulative

- 17 <u>approaches to teaching phonemic awareness, phonics, vocabulary, fluency, and text</u>
- 18 <u>comprehension; and</u>
- (C) Employ multisensory and multimodal intervention strategies;
- 20 (3) Content literacy and mathematics practices;
- 21 (4) Strategies appropriate for the instruction of English language learners;
- 22 (5) Strategies appropriate for the instruction of students with disabilities;
- 23 (6) Strategies to differentiate instruction based on student needs;
- 24 (7) Strategies and practices to support research based content aligned to state standards
- 25 <u>and grading practices;</u>
- 26 (8) Strategies appropriate for the early identification of a student with a reading
- 27 <u>deficiency; and</u>
- 28 (9) Strategies to support the use of technology in education and distance learning."
- SECTION 2.
- 30 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
